## NEW DEADLINES (quick overview)

	New deadline	Previous deadline
<b>Phase 1 - Announcement of the conflict to the conflicting parties</b> By the conflict announcement AGICOA sets to the parties a deadline of 90 calendar days to react to AGICOA's announcement of the conflict.	90 days	120 days
<b>Phase 1 - Relaunch - New rightsholder joining the conflict</b> In case of a third party joining an existing conflict resolution procedure before the end of the 90 days deadline that starts to run after the initial conflict announcement, AGICOA shall restart the conflict resolution procedure and the 90 days deadline shall start to run again.	90 days	120 days
<b>Phase 2 - Communication of the ongoing conflict</b> In case both parties confirm their rights in Phase 1, the conflict enters into Phase 2, where reasonable substantiation of rights is required. AGICOA shall notify the parties to provide said substantiation in 60 days.	60 days	90 days
<b>Phase 2 - Accelerated Conflict Resolution Procedure</b> In case a request to start an accelerated conflict resolution procedure is accepted by AGICOA's Legal & Licensing Department, AGICOA sets to the parties a deadline of 60 calendar days to react to AGICOA's announcement of the conflict.	60 days	90 days
<b>Phase 3 - Final recommendation</b> After receipt of AGICOA's final recommendation for resolution of the conflict, the parties shall have 60 calendar days to react to it.	60 days	90 days
<b>Phase 3 - Rejection of Final recommendation</b> If AGICOA's final recommendation is totally or partially rejected by at least one of the conflicting parties, AGICOA shall set a deadline of 30 calendar days for the conflicting parties to either start litigation, arbitration or agree on a different settlement between themselves, and to inform AGICOA about one of the abovementioned options.	30 days	60 days
<b>Phase 3 - Extension of deadline in case of rejection of Final Recommendation</b> In case of rejection of the Final Recommendation, parties must notify AGICOA of the start of litigation, arbitration, or the reach of an agreement on a different settlement between themselves. AGICOA shall then notify the parties to request additional documents to prove said option has been effectively agreed and adopted. Parties shall have 30 days to respond by sending the appropriate documents.	30 days	60 days
<b>Phase 3 - Implementation of Final recommendation despite rejection</b> Despite their rejection of the recommendation, the conflicting parties are deemed to have accepted AGICOA's Final recommendation if they fail to start litigation, arbitration, or to reach a settlement agreement within the deadline of 30 calendar days and to inform AGICOA accordingly. As a result AGICOA shall implement its recommendation in 30 days.	30 days	60 days
